



<u>Pre-Matric Scholarship for Disabled Students – State</u> <u>Government Scheme</u>

Objective of the Scheme:

The scheme aims to encourage education among disabled students.

Eligible Categories:

As per the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, individuals belonging to any of the 21 disability categories are eligible for the scheme.

Eligibility Criteria:

The applicant must have at least 40% disability. The applicant must be a resident of Maharashtra. The student must be studying from Class 1 to Class 10 and must not have failed in the previous academic year. No income limit is applicable for eligibility.

Scholarship Benefits:

Class 1 to 4 (for visually impaired students in pre-primary education) – \Box 100 per month per student.

Class 5 to $7 - \Box$ 150 per month per student.

Class 8 to $10 - \Box 200$ per month per student.

Students up to 18 years of age with intellectual disabilities or mental illnesses - \Box 150 per month per student.

Disabled trainees in workshops $- \Box$ 300 per month per student.

Application Process:

The applicant must fill out the prescribed application form and submit it along with the required documents through their respective school.

Educational Scholarship
